GENERAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Tournamentdesk:

The tournament desk is located on the ground floor directly next to the stairs. Responsible crew for the planning and execution of the tournament: Event director Pavel Sladecek.

In the Kaifu Lodge, there will be a representative as well to help out.

The Tournament Referee is Marko Podgorsek.

All rules as stated in the official entry form and ESF regulations apply. All results will be displayed in the center and online (Tournament Software).

Practice Courts

On Monday during the day, all courts will be available to all players for free. On Tuesday until the first matches start as well. This only applies to Sportwerk!

If you want to practice in the Kaifu Lodge, you have to make reservations directly with the center.

Games & Starting times

Be aware that the matches will not be announced when they start. This means that each player is personally responsible to be in time at the designated court for his game. This also implies that if previous matches cause a delay or finish early the player has to be present as soon as the preceding match is finished.

After the match, BOTH players have to ref the next match. After finishing refereeing, the refs are asked to bring to score sheet AS SOON AS POSSIBLE to the tournament desk. In this way, delays can be prevented.

Of course, if the refereeing happens via tablet, you no further action is needed. We try to do this for as many courts as possible.











Courts:

In Sportwerk: the tournament will be played on all courts 1-14 and Glasscourt

In Kaifu Lodge: the tournament will be played on courts 1-4 and 6

When you play in the Kaifu Lodge, you have to show your badge at the entrance. If you want a locker there, they will provide you with a black bracelet.

Bags

Since we use all courts for the tournament, there will be no extra room for bags. Therefore, we kindly ask you to place them in a neat manner. With 600 people in the center, it otherwise might be messy and packed. Be aware that we do not take responsibility for your belongings. Valuables should be stored in our lockers.

Physiotherapy:

The physiotherapist, Rösi Bittner. Please contact via the tournament referee or reception desk. The physio is free of charge. She will be available from Wednesday onwards.

WIFI

There is no WIFI available during the tournament.

In the tournament hotel free WIFI is provided for everyone. For your access in the center, contact the reception desk.

OPENING HOURS CENTERS

On Monday and Tuesday only Sportwerk is available for practice. Kaifu Lodge will be available only on matchdays, when matches are played there.

SPORTWERK

Monday:

The center is open for practice from 10:00 - 21:00Courts cannot be reserved, as it wouldn't be fair to anyone of the other 520 participants.

You can come and play spontaneously and free of charge.

Tuesday

The center will be open from 10:00 – 23:00. Don't forget our Meet & Greet at 19:00! Qualification matches start at 17:30!

The restaurant will be open from 12:00 – 22:00.

Wednesday-Friday

Center open: 7:30 – 24:00 Restaurant open: 8:00 – 23:00

Saturday

Center open: 7:30 – 21:00 Restaurant open: 8:00 – 20:00

KAIFU LODGE

Matchdays the center is open from 6:30 to 23:00.









FOOD & DRINKS SPORTWERK CENTER

Food

During the whole tournament we offer freshly made buffets in our restaurant. The food package had to be bought at registration. You can take your meal during lunch or dinner, that's your choice! The buffet is available between 12:00 and 21:00.

The restaurant will try to provide one additional dish for spontaneous guests. Sandwiches, energy bars or fruits can be bought at the reception desk.

Drinks

There are three locations within Sportwerk, where you can buy drinks:

- 1. The restaurant has coffee, softdrinks and beer and other alcoholic beverages
- 2. Reception desk has bottled beer, softdrinks and water.
- 3. The 'beer bar' next to the glasscourt only has tap beer. Payment here can only be made with our beer card.

The beer card is a 10 beer card which is sold at $35 \in$ in order to provide the beerdrinkers with a lower price. A single beer will cost $4,5 \in$. So the beer card makes sense if you intend to drink a few beers!

FOOD & DRINKS KAIFU LODGE CENTER

There is a restaurant in the Kaifu Lodge. The food package and the beercard cannot be used here!

The restaurant is located next to the squashcourts. Here you can buy food and drinks as you wish.

From 12:00 onwards, there is a salad bar. Warm food is available from 18:00 onwards.











FINAL DINNER / PLAYERS PARTY

Everyone, who booked the final dinner, is kindly invited to be at the tournament hotel Linder Hagenbeck Hotel between 18:30 and 19:00.

The dinner will start at 19:00!

The bottles of water on the table are free of charge. Any additional drinks have to be paid for.

After the dinner, our DJ Mika will be there to provide you with good music to dance!

The party will be finished latest by 2:30. Therefore, the restaurant will provide drinks until 2:00.

Of course, you can party longer, but then you would need make your way into the city center!
